- Opened in January 2013 following an extensive refurbishment, The Maslow is the ultimate business hotel in Sandton, offering some of the best corporate facilities, technology and services.
- The hotel is situated in the heart of Sandton's financial district, home to top investment banks, financial institutions and the Johannesburg Stock Exchange.
- A complimentary scheduled return transfer service runs approximately every 30 minutes within a 3km radius of the hotel and includes stops at the Sandton Gautrain station, Nelson Mandela Square and Sandton City.
- Wayfarer Transit Lounge is a complimentary comfortable space for business travellers to work from, take a shower or have a light meal and refreshments – ideal for early check-ins or late departures.
- Complimentary breakfast is offered to all residents of the hotel.
- The Maslow offers free, uncapped high speed Wifi.
