

MISS SOUTH AFRICA 2014 TO RECEIVE PRIZES IN EXCESS OF R1.3 MILLION

Winner also receives money and bursaries to give away during her reign

The bouquet of prizes that Miss South Africa will receive makes the pageant one of the richest beauty competitions in the world

The winner – to be crowned at a dazzling ceremony to be held at Sun City on Sunday, March 30 – will receive cash, a car and products valued at more than R1.3 million. She also gets thousands of rands in cash and study bursaries to award to South Africans that she meets during her reign.
