Double Zero Roulette

Double Zero Roulette is an exciting, fun filled casino game with a wide variety of bets. All you need to know is how to place your bets. We hope you enjoy playing Double Zero Roulette with Sun International.

The Aim of the Game

The object of Double Zero Roulette is to guess on which number on the wheel the ball will come to rest. Every number has the same chance as any other of coming up on each spin i.e. the winning number on any spin has no effect on the outcome of the next spin.

The Double Zero Roulette Wheel

Double Zero Roulette wheel is made up of 38 segments, Zero, Double Zero and 36 numbers with 18 black numbers and 18 red numbers.

Double Zero Roulette Bets and Payouts

Double Zero Roulette allows players to make a wide range of betting options. Refer to the pay table for easy reference.

Double Zero Roulette Chips

Double Zero Roulette is played with special chips called colour chips. When you buy at the table, using your cash or smart MVG card, you will be given your own uniquely coloured chips to distinguish your bets from the other players. You determine the value of your chips when you buy in at the table. When you have finished playing, your colour chips must be exchanged for casino value chips as they cannot be used anywhere else in the casino.

When Zero or Double Zero Wins

- All Dozen and Column bets lose.
- Even bets lose half wager.
- All other bets not placed on Zero or Double Zero or combinations of Zero or Double Zero lose.

Placing your bets

Before spinning the wheel, the dealer will announce the start of a new game by calling, "Place your bets".

The dealer will spin the wheel and you may continue to place bets until the dealer calls "No more bets". No further bets will be accepted after this announcement.

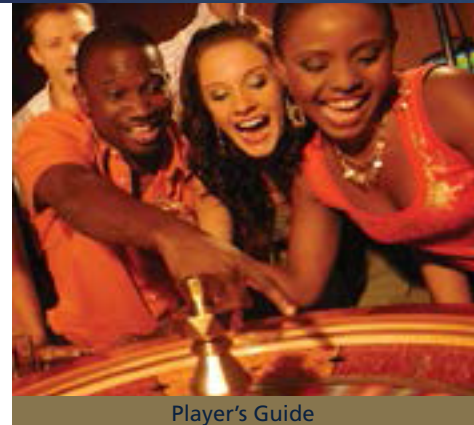
Remember you are responsible for placing your chips correctly as each bet will be paid out in strict accordance with its position on the table when the ball rests.

The dealer will call out the winning number, its colour and place to the dolly on the winning number.

The table is cleared of all losing bets and then the dealer will pay out the winners, announcing the amount of winning chips for each colour being played.

	A bet on any single number e.g. 0,3,7	35 to 1
B	Split	
	A bet on any two adjacent numbers e.g. 8 - 11	17 to 1
C	Street	
	A bet on a line of three adjacent numbers e.g. 10, 11, 12	11 to 1
D	Corner	
	A bet on any four adjacent numbers e.g. 13, 14, 16, 17	8 to 1
E	Five Line	
	A bet on the first five numbers which are 0, 00, 1, 2 and 3	6 to 1
F	Six Line	
	A bet on two adjacent rows of numbers e.g. 19, 20, 21 and 22, 23,24	5 to 1
G	Dozen	
	A bet on twelve consecutive numbers: 1 to 12, 13 to 24 or 25 to 36	2 to 1
H	Columns	
	A bet on all twelve numbers in a column 1 to 34, 2 to 35, 3 to 36	2 to 1
I	Red or Black	
	A bet placed on all the red or black numbers	1 to 1
J	Odd or Even	
	A bet on all the odd or even numbers	1 to 1
K	High or Low	
	A bet on eighteen consecutive numbers: 1 to 18 or 19 to 36	1 to 1
